



Eighth Workshop in Economic Development (Chile)

Call for Papers

We invite all interested researchers to submit their papers to the Eighth Workshop in Economic Development. The workshop will take place in Santiago, Chile on Thursday December 19th of 2019. It will be held at Universidad Alberto Hurtado (Santiago, Chile).

The objective of this conference is to gather a select number of papers in economic development (broadly defined), which will be presented to an audience of researchers working in related areas in Chile.

Professor Rodrigo Soares from Columbia University and Professor Raquel Fernandez from New York University have confirmed their participation in the workshop and will deliver two keynote presentations during the conference.

The conference will consist of single track sessions with a maximum of 6 papers in total, with individual discussants for each paper and ample time from the public for discussion and reactions to the paper. We especially invite papers that have not yet been submitted to academic journals. The deadline for submissions is September 30th, 2019. Papers should be submitted following [this link](#). The organizing committee will contact selected authors by October 30th, 2019.

Limited funding for travel might be available. Please indicate when submitting if you need financial aid. We will let know selected papers as soon as possible if this financial aid is available.
