The School of Government and the Institute of Economics at Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile invites applications to one full-time interdisciplinary position for Assistant Professor, starting March 2020.

### **Job Qualifications**

The candidate is expected to have a PhD degree in social sciences (Economics, Political Science, Public Policy, Sociology or related fields). The candidate must be able to teach at the School of Government and the Institute of Economics. Candidates must possess strong teaching skills, must have a commitment to research excellence and should display a high level of team spirit. The successful candidate will conduct interdisciplinary research, teach at undergraduate and graduate levels, and also contribute to the public policy debate. Fluent Spanish is required after one year.

### **Application procedure**

Late applications may be considered until the position is filled.

1. Research statement indicating immediate and long-term research goals. Specify potential research networks and plans for collaborating with researchers in Chile and other countries.
2. Teaching statement of purpose indicating why the applicant should be considered for the position and her/his teaching plans. Be as specific as possible e.g., giving examples of how the applicant plans to transfer her/his knowledge to undergraduate and graduate students.
3. Up-to-date curriculum vitae.
4. Copies of your most important publications, working papers, or thesis chapters highlighting their contribution to knowledge (up to five).
5. An official copy of the candidate's graduate transcripts (including the PhD degree).
6. In addition, candidates should arrange for two letters of recommendation to be uploaded through the advertisement link.

Once the complete set of application materials has been received, the applicant will be contacted within two weeks after the deadline and informed whether her/his application has been accepted for further consideration. If this initial screening is successful, the candidate will be invited to give a job talk on her/his current research topics and hold interviews with the faculty members from the Selection Committee.

Documents can be sent in English or Spanish.
